WHO

The Freedom Bus is for St Leonards-On-Sea, Hastings & Rother Black and Global Majority Residents and their chosen families.

This means to book for this event you:

- Must live in Hastings and Rother
- Identify as either Black and or Global Majority

Your chosen families:

- Must live in Hastings and Rother
- Do not need to identify as Black and or Global Majority
- Can be the people closest to your heart who may or may not be your legal or biological family
- Can be your legal or biological family

GLOBAL MAJORITY

Global majority refers to people who are NOT white British or other white-identifying groups and who are often racialized as "ethnic minorities." It can include people who are Black, African, Asian, Brown, dual-heritage, indigenous to the Global South, and mixed. Together, these groups make up around 80–85% of the world's population.

ACCESS

Travelling in the Coach:

- It takes approximately 2.5 hours to travel to London
- Along the way, we will stop at some motorway services
- To get on the coach, there are four steps
